

## KINGSFORD CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE

### COMMERCIAL VENDOR RULES

THURSDAY - FRIDAY - SATURDAY AUGUST 3 - 5, 2023

1. Space fee is \$25 per front foot with a depth of up to 20 feet. You must weight or stake down any tents or canopies. If your tent is not weighted or staked down properly and blows over and damages your neighbor's space, you are responsible for damages incurred.
2. All vendors must be set up and ready to open by 4pm Thurs, 3pm Fri, 11am Sat (CST.) If your space does not allow for a parked vehicle, all vehicles need to be moved into the designated parking area before opening. Be sure to unload most of your product prior to moving your vehicle.
3. All vendors will be required to supply a Driver License/Identification Card number on the application and may be asked to show ID.
4. The sale of all guns including BB-Guns and Tasers, knives, fireworks, tobacco, e-cigarettes and accessories, drug paraphernalia, pornography or other commodities prohibited by laws, including any merchandise that violates trademark, trade name or copyright laws will not be permitted.
5. No carry in food or alcoholic beverages may be sold or consumed on the grounds. Violators will be asked to leave.
6. Vendors are to comply with all requirements of Federal, State or Local Authorities and to indemnify members of the Kingsford Centennial Committee, City of Kingsford and Kingsford Centennial Committee staff from all liability.
7. Camping is not allowed.
8. YOU ARE NOT TO SHUT DOWN BEFORE 9 pm each night without prior arrangements which must be approved by the Centennial Committee. The grounds will be closed by midnight each night.
9. The City of Kingsford Centennial Committee is not responsible for theft, damage to merchandise, or injury occurring at the event. Over-night security will be provided on the grounds.
10. No pets allowed unless it is a valid service animal and must be kept on a leash at all times, and you are required to clean up after your animal. The sale of animals is prohibited.
11. Audio device volume is to be kept LOW. You will be required to turn the device OFF if you do not comply.
12. No refunds will be given once you have paid for your space(s). This event will be held rain or shine.

13. Ensure you properly pack up and clean up your area before you leave. Trash receptacles are provided on the grounds or you may take your trash with you. Please do not leave your trash in the restrooms or anywhere else on the grounds.
14. There will be a \$50 service charge on NSF checks.
15. Vendors are not allowed to use a charcoal grill or gas grill in their vending area.
16. Generators used by vendors must be in good working condition and run cleanly and smoothly. A fire extinguisher should also be placed near the generator in case of fire. If your generator does not comply, you will not be allowed to participate as a vendor. Generator exhaust must be directed away from human occupancy to protect from carbon monoxide poisoning. Decibel levels should be at 90 dBA or lower.
17. Unethical and fraudulent business practices will not be tolerated. This will be grounds for eviction with no refund of any kind and you may be reported to Kingsford Public Safety.
18. The Centennial Committee reserves the right to make immediate necessary rule changes as needed and to take whatever action is necessary to ensure safety, security and wellness of event Staff, Visitors, and Vendors.

*Any infraction of these rules will be grounds for immediate eviction.*

*The Centennial Committee reserves the right to refuse to rent space to anyone for any reason.*
